Introduction

1. By an application filed on 26 April 2023, the Applicant contests the Administration’s decision to “close her complaint filed with the Office of Internal Oversight Services alleging harassment and abuse of authority against Ms. Annie Muchai, her former Second Reporting Officer.”
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 2 June 2023 submitting that the contested decision was lawful.
3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion (“CMD”). The purpose of the CMD is to:
 - a. discuss and identify the claims and issues in the case;
 - b. discuss any possibility for an amicable resolution of the case; and
 - c. generally deal with any other matter relating to the consideration and determination of this application.

4. A CMD in this case will take place on **Thursday, 22 February 2024 at 1500 hrs** (Nairobi Time, UTC +3) via Microsoft Teams.
