## **Introduction**

1. By an application filed on 26 April 2023, the Applicant contests the Administration's decision to "close her complaint filed with the Office of Internal Oversight Services alleging harassment and abuse of authority against her former Second Reporting Officer."
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 2 June 2023 submitting that the contested decision was lawful.
3. The Tribunal held a case management discussion ("CMD") on 22 February 2024. At the CMD, the Applicant averred that "no genuine and serious investigation was undertaken". The Applicant, accordingly, indicated that she needs to call 12 witnesses to prove her case. Further, the Applicant reiterated her request for production of documents contained in para. 51 of her application.
4. On his part, the Respondent submits that a hearing is not necessary.

## **Consideration**

5. The Tribunal is of the view that prior to deciding on whether a hearing is necessary or not, the Applicant is required to submit a summary of what each witness will testify about and what the documents she requests for will show.

## **Conclusion**

6. In view of the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED that on or before **Friday, 1 March 2024**, the Applicant shall file a summary of:
  - a. What testimony each witness would provide; and
