Introduction

1. By an application filed on 26 April 2023, the Applicant contests the Administration’s decision to “close her complaint filed with the Office of Internal Oversight Services alleging harassment and abuse of authority against her former Second Reporting Officer.” The Application also included a motion for production of evidence.

2. The Respondent filed his reply on 2 June 2023 submitting that the contested decision was lawful. The reply also argued that the production of documents was an improper attempt to have the Dispute Tribunal “review the facts in a bid to consider the correctness of the choice made by the Executive Director”.

3. In her response to Order No. 25 (NBI/2024), filed on 27 February 2024, the Applicant expanded on her request for production of evidence made in her application.

Consideration

4. The Tribunal finds that it is in the interest of justice to give the Respondent an opportunity to respond to the Applicant’s above-mentioned 27 February 2024 submission related to her request for production of evidence.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT on or before **Monday, 25 March 2024**, the Respondent shall file his response, if any, to the Applicant’s 27 February 2024 submission related to her request for production of evidence.
