Introduction

1. On 10 July 2023, the Applicant, a former Construction and Maintenance Worker at the United Nations Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, filed an application contesting a decision of 1 May 2023 to separate him from service with compensation *in lieu* of notice and without termination indemnity.

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 10 August 2023 and requests the Tribunal to reject the application. He contends that there is clear and convincing evidence in support of the sanction imposed on the Applicant.

Consideration

3. The Tribunal has decided to hold the hearing on the merits of this case in the week commencing on 24 June 2024. The parties are required to confirm their availability in the proposed week. The parties are also required to submit the names of their proposed witnesses and to indicate whether any of their proposed witnesses will require interpretation services.

Conclusion

4. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED that the parties shall each:
- a. Confirm their availability during the proposed week commencing on 24 June 2024 for a hearing by close of business **on Friday, 31 May 2024;**
 - b. Submit a list of their witnesses and the subject about which each witness will testify not later than **Friday, 31 May 2024;** and
 - c. Indicate which of their witnesses will require interpretation services, and if so, from what language.
