ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. On 18 July 2023, the Applicant filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal sitting in Nairobi to challenge the disciplinary measure imposed on him by the Respondent. The Applicant was issued with a written censure and his salary increment was deferred for two years in accordance with staff rules 10.2(a)(i) and (iii).

2. On 21 August 2023, the Respondent replied to the application. The Respondent urged the Tribunal to dismiss the application in its entirety.

3. On 5 September 2023, the Applicant sought leave to file further submissions. This was granted on 14 September 2023.

4. On 27 September 2023, the Applicant filed submissions in response to the Respondent's reply.

5. The Tribunal called for a case management discussion ("CMD") with the parties, which took place on 30 July 2024.

The Discussion

6. Counsel for the Applicant will file a tabular document indicating the putative translation issues in this case for the Tribunal's assessment and consideration.

7. The parties agree that the record is otherwise complete as is, and that there is no need for an oral hearing.

8. The parties also agree to engage in settlement discussions over the next 30 days.

Conclusion

9. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

a. Counsel for the Applicant will file a submission on the disputed translations by **Thursday**, **15** August **2024**; and

b. The Parties will file their respective closing submission by Friday,30 August 2024.
