Introduction

1. By Order No. 78 (NBI/2024), issued on 27 June 2024, a hearing on the merits in this case was scheduled to take place on 22-23 August 2024.

Consideration

2. The above hearing took place as scheduled (22 August 2024) and, at the end of it, the parties agreed to file their respective closing arguments within three weeks.

Conclusion

3. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
- a. The evidence is now declared closed;
 - b. By **Monday, 23 September 2024**, the parties will file their closing arguments; and
 - c. By **Monday, 30 September 2024**, the Applicant, will file his rebuttal, if any, to the Respondent's closing arguments.
4. The closing arguments of each party shall:
- a. Exclusively refer to evidence already on file; and
 - b. Not exceed **10 pages**, using Times New Roman, font size 12 pts and 1.5 line spacing.
