1. By Order No. 110 (NBI/2024), issued on 20 August 2024, a hearing on the merits in this case was scheduled to take place on 17 September 2024.

#### Conclusion

  - a. Exclusively refer to evidence already on file; and

b. Not exceed five pages, using Times New Roman, font size 12 pts and1.5 line spacing.
