ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. On 28 June 2024, the Applicant filed an application challenging his separation from service with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indemnity for sexual misconduct.
2. The Respondent's reply was due on 1 August 2024.
3. On 30 July 2024, the Respondent filed his reply together with a motion seeking leave to exceed the 10-page limit for the reply on the grounds that the additional facts and analysis would assist the Tribunal to efficiently and effectively address the issues in this case.
4. On 31 July 2024 the Tribunal issued Order No. 99 (NBI/2024) partly granting the motion. The Respondent was directed to restrict his reply to 12 pages and to file it by 15 August 2024, which he did.

Consideration and Conclusion

5. Having taken into consideration the pleadings of the parties, the Tribunal considers it appropriate to hold a hearing on the merits in this case.
6. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
 - a. By **Thursday, 24 October 2024**, the parties shall file their lists of witnesses and their expected testimony; and
 - b. Inform the Tribunal of their availability to attend a Case Management Discussion on **Thursday, 7 November 2024**.
