Introduction

1. The Applicant is an Administrative Associate at the UN Women Jerusalem Office at the G-6 level. On 29 August 2024, he filed an application contesting the decision of the UN Women Director, Division of Management and Administration, in relation to retaliation following a reporting of misconduct.

2. On 15 November 2024, the Tribunal issued Order No. 154 (NBI/2024) encouraging the parties to explore the possibility of having the dispute between them resolved without recourse to further litigation. On 14 December 2024, the Applicant filed a motion requesting the Tribunal to withdraw his case.

Consideration

3. The Tribunal commends the parties for their sustained efforts at resolving this dispute amicably and without recourse to further litigation.

4. In view of the foregoing, the Tribunal makes the following ORDERS that:

a. The Applicant's motion for withdrawal is hereby **GRANTED**;

b. The matter of *Milhem v Secretary-General of the United Nations*, registered under Case No. UNDT/NBI/2024/057, be struck off the Tribunal's docket.
