### Introduction

1. Pursuant to Order No. 60 (NBI/2025), the Applicant's rejoinder to the reply was due on 29 April 2025. On said date, upon *ex parte* motion from the Applicant,

the Tribunal issued Order No. 65 (NBI/2025) setting a new deadline of 6 May 2025.

2. On 5 May 2025, the Applicant filed a Motion requesting a new time-extension

of a month to submit the rejoinder. The Motion and annexes were filed ex parte.

The Applicant also requests the Tribunal not to share the Motion with the

Respondent.

#### Consideration

3. The Tribunal, noting the medical emergency grounds on which the *ex parte* 

Motion is based, determines that the Applicant has presented exceptional

circumstances that justify the request for an extension of time to file her application.

4. The Tribunal further notes that the grounds on which the Applicant requests

that the Motion not be shared with the Respondent are not justified but will accept

the ex parte filing of the annexes to the Motion. Considering that the deadline for

filing the rejoinder falls today, Tuesday, 6 May 2025, it will not violate the

principles of natural justice and due process not to give the Respondent an

opportunity to reply. See, for example, Wynn 2024-UNAT-1419, para. 31.

a. The Applicant's Motion for an extension of time to file a rejoinder to

the reply is GRANTED.

b. The rejoinder will be filed by **Tuesday**, **3 June 2025**.
