Introduction and background

1. The Applicant contests a 19 August 2024 decision communicated to her by

the ECSWA Director of Administration to deny her request, made on medical

grounds, for remote work ("contested decision").

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 24 March 2025 arguing that the application

is not receivable ratione materiae. On the merits, the Respondent submits that the

contested decision was lawful, reasonable, procedurally fair and that the Executive

Secretary ECSWA reasonably exercised her discretion under ST/SGB/2019/3

(Flexible working arrangements).

3. The Applicant filed a rejoinder on 29 April 2025 which, *inter alia*, addresses

the receivability argument.

Considerations

4. The Tribunal has reviewed the evidence on record and finds that an oral

hearing on the merits would not add further value in this respect. Consequently, the

present case will be determined on the written pleadings without holding a hearing

on the merits. However, the parties may file closing submissions if they so choose.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

a. The parties shall file any closing submissions by 5 p.m. (Nairobi time)

Monday, 8 September 2025.

b. The said submissions should not exceed five pages, in font Times New

Roman, font size 12, line spacing of 1.5 lines.
