Introduction

1. The Applicant, a former staff member, working with the Office for the

Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs filed an application contesting a decision

awarding him partial reimbursement of his claim for the loss of personal effects and

for his dependents following the outbreak of war in Sudan and their evacuation.

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 23 August 2025, where it argued that the

contested decision is lawful as it was made in line with staff rule 6.5,

ST/AI/149/Rev.4 and ST/AI/149/Rev.4/Amend.1. (Compensation for loss of or

damage to personal effects attributable to service).

Consideration

3. Having examined the evidence on record to date, the Tribunal finds that the

case is briefed enough, and that the matter can be determined without holding a

hearing or submission of additional evidence. However, the parties may file closing

submissions if they so desire.

Conclusion

4. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

a. On or before Wednesday, 17 September 2025, the parties may file

closing submissions if they choose.

b. The submissions shall not exceed **five pages**, using Times New Roman,

font size 12 pts and 1.5 line spacing.
