Introduction

1. By application filed on 12 June 2025, the Applicant, a former Administrative Assistant with the United Nations Mission in South Sudan, filed an application challenging a 12 May 2025 decision to impose upon him the disciplinary sanction of separation from service for misconduct, and to place his name in ClearCheck.
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 18 July 2025.
3. The Applicant filed a rejoinder on 11 August 2025.
4. In response to Order No. 159 (NBI/2025), on 25 September 2025, the Applicant filed submissions seeking to produce oral evidence at an oral hearing before the Tribunal.
5. On 2 October 2025, the Respondent filed a motion for leave to respond to the Applicant's submissions on oral evidence.

Consideration

6. Pursuant to art. 19 of its Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal may at any time issue any order or give any direction appearing to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of a case and to do justice to the parties.
7. Having taken into consideration the Respondent's motion, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the interest of justice to grant the motion.

Conclusion

8. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
 - a. The Respondent's motion is granted.

- b. On or before **Thursday, 9 October 2025**, the Respondent shall file his response to the Applicant's submissions filed on 25 September 2025.
