Introduction

1. The Applicant is contesting the denial of her request that the official United Nations records be updated to reflect her status as official dependent spouse and beneficiary, under Brazilian law, of a deceased staff member, Mr. Sergio Vieira de Mello.

2. The Respondent argues that the application is neither receivable *ratione temporis* nor *ratione materiae*.

Consideration

3. The Tribunal deems it appropriate to provide the Applicant an opportunity to respond to the Respondent's arguments. Thus, the Applicant may file a rejoinder.

ORDERS

4. By **5 p.m. (Nairobi time) on Tuesday, 14 October 2025**, the Applicant shall file a rejoinder specifically addressing the issue of receivability raised by the Respondent.

5. The rejoinder shall not exceed five pages (excluding the cover and signature pages), in font Times New Roman, font size 12, line spacing of 1.5 lines.
