Introduction

1. The Applicant served as a Human Resources Officer on a continuing

appointment with the United Nations Human Settlement Programme (UN-Habitat)

in Nairobi. He filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal

challenging the Respondent's decision to "impose a post-separation sanction" on

him.

2. The Tribunal held a case management discussion with the parties on

8 October 2025.

The Discussion

3. The Tribunal noted that the parties' submissions in this case are sloppy and

provided several examples of citations to jurisprudence and staff rules that are

plainly wrong. While an occasional typographical error can be overlooked, when

nearly all the citations are incorrect that cannot be permitted.

4. The Tribunal made it clear that it is not the Tribunal's responsibility to search

the jurisprudence hoping to find authorities that are incorrectly cited. Thus, any

incorrect citations will be disregarded and not considered by the Tribunal in its

deliberations.

5. Counsel for the Applicant undertook to correct all the erroneous citations in

his closing submissions.

6. Both parties agree that a hearing is not necessary and that this case can be

adjudicated on the papers. To which end, the Tribunal set deadlines for the filing of

closing submissions.

Conclusion

7. The Tribunal made the following ORDERS:

a. The Applicant will file his closing submissions on or before

17 October 2025;
