ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former Senior Supply Assistant, working with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (“UNHCR”) based in Aden, Yemen. He contests a disciplinary measure of dismissal imposed on him.
2. The Respondent submitted a reply on 18 August 2025.
3. The Applicant filed a rejoinder to the reply on 12 September 2025.
4. By a joint motion filed on 10 November 2025, the parties moved the Tribunal to suspend proceedings until 5 December 2025. They indicate that they have agreed to enter into discussions to explore the possibility of informal resolution of the dispute.

Consideration

5. The Tribunal deems it appropriate to suspend the proceedings in this matter as requested by the parties, so as to allow them time to engage in settlement discussions.

Conclusion

6. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
 - a. The proceedings before the Tribunal shall be suspended until **Friday, 5 December 2025** for the purpose of allowing the parties to engage in settlement discussions;
 - b. If a settlement agreement is reached within this period, the parties shall inform the Tribunal accordingly without delay, and the Applicant shall confirm to the Tribunal, in writing, that his application is withdrawn; or

c. If no settlement can be reached within the prescribed period, the parties shall inform the Tribunal, which will resume the proceedings in the matter.
