Introduction

1. The Applicant was a Security Officer at the FS-5 level with the United Nations Mission in South Sudan (“UNMISS”), based in Juba. On 27 August 2025, he filed this application challenging the administration’s decision to impose on him the disciplinary sanction of separation from service for serious misconduct following an investigation, and to place his name in the ClearCheck misconduct database.

Consideration

2. By Order No. 225 (NBI/2025), dated 13 November 2025, the Tribunal granted the Respondent’s motion to exceed the page limit, and noticed the parties of its intent to hold a case management discussion (CMD) in this matter.

3. The parties were directed to provide dates for the CMD by Thursday, 27 November. Both parties have responded with their availability.

Conclusion

4. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

a. A CMD in this case will take place on **Thursday, 11 December 2025 at 2:30pm** (Nairobi time, UTC +3) via Microsoft Teams.

b. The parties or their duly designated representatives must attend the CMD. The Registry will provide a link to access the meeting prior to the hearing date.
