Introduction

1. The Applicant is the Chief of the Air Operations Unit with the United Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara (“MINURSO”). On 13 November 2025, he filed an application seeking to suspend, pending management evaluation, a decision by the Head of Mission (“HOM”) to terminate his continuous appointment, effective 9 February 2026.
2. The Applicant filed a management evaluation request on 11 November 2025 and has not yet received a response.
3. The Respondent was served with the application and filed a reply which argued that the matter was not receivable because the HOM had informed the Applicant of his decision to suspend the notice of termination, pending management evaluation, “and until said evaluation is issued within the statutory deadline.”

Consideration

4. In light of the HOM’s determination to suspend implementation of the contested decision, the remedy sought by the Applicant has been realized, and accordingly, the application is moot.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, it is IT IS ORDERED THAT is dismissed as moot.
