Introduction

1. On 21 May 2025, the Applicant filed an application contesting a 9 December 2024 decision rejecting her request for an Inter-Agency Secondment to the International Labour Organization by the United Nations Office of the

Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process.

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 10 July 2025.

3. On 14 October 2025 the Applicant filed a motion seeking leave to adduce

additional documents in support of her claim for moral damages, distress and

hardship.

4. On 4 November 2025, the Respondent filed a motion seeking leave to submit

documents referenced as annexes R/6-R/8 to supplement his reply of 10 July 2025.

5. On 16 November 2025, the Applicant sought leave to file submissions

opposing the Respondent's 4 November motion; the Applicant's submissions were

attached.

Considerations

6. Article 18.1 of the Rules of Procedure provides that the "Dispute Tribunal

shall determine the admissibility of any evidence." The Tribunal has carefully

considered the submissions made by the parties in their motions and determines that

they may assist in the fair and expeditious disposal of this case. The probative value

of these new documents will be determined in the judgment drafting stage.

7. The Tribunal is now fully apprised of the legal issues arising for

determination in this case and does not consider an oral hearing necessary. The

parties, however, may file brief closing submissions.

Conclusion

8. The parties' motions dated 14 October 2025, 4 and 16 November 2025, are

granted.
