Introduction and background

1. On 13 November 2025, the Respondent filed a motion requesting to exceed

the page limit in filing his reply. The Respondent submits that the case involves

"the submission of 23 false provider claims and the Applicant's failure to cooperate

with the duly authorized investigation." The additional pages will enable the

Respondent to present a comprehensive and complete picture of events surrounding

the contested decision.

Considerations

2. The Tribunal agrees that the factual background is lengthy and that the ten-

page limit prescribed in Practice Direction 4 may be inadequate to fully address the

matters. However, it does appear that the Reply is overly lengthy and contains

extensive quotes from the annexes in the record. It seems that the Respondent did

not make efforts to be concise and direct.

3. However, the Tribunal notes that closing submissions have already been

ordered. Denying the motion would only serve to delay disposition of the case.

Order

4. The Respondent's motion to exceed the page limit in the reply is granted, and

the Reply is accepted in its current form.
