## Introduction

1. By application filed on 24 October 2025, the Applicant contests the decision of the Advisory Board on Compensation Claims not to reimburse him non-medical expenses incurred as a consequence of a work-related injury.
2. The Respondent submitted a reply on 27 November 2025 where it is argued that the contested decision is not receivable and if found receivable, the application lacks merit.

## Consideration

3. Pursuant to art. 19 of its Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal may at any time issue an order or give any direction appearing to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of a case and to do justice to the parties.
4. Having taken into consideration the pleadings of the parties, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the interest of justice to give the Applicant an opportunity to comment on the Respondent's reply by means of a rejoinder.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT

5. By **Friday, 19 December 2025**, the Applicant shall file a rejoinder addressing the Respondent's arguments in the reply, and **more specifically** responding to the receivability issues raised by the Respondent.
