ORDER

ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. On 21 March 2016, the Applicant, an Investigator at the P-4 level, step 8, with the Office of Internal Oversight Services, filed an application in French in which he contests that the Under-Secretary-General for Management dismissed two complaints which the Applicant had submitted against the Officer-in-Charge of the Management Evaluation Unit pursuant to ST/SGB/2008/5 (Prohibition of Discrimination, Harassment, Including Sexual Harassment, and Abuse of Authority) and ST/AI/371 (Revised Disciplinary Measures and Procedures), respectively.

2. On 22 March 2016, the Registry acknowledged receipt of the application and instructed the Respondent to submit his reply by 21 April 2016. The parties were further informed that they would be notified whenever the English version of the application would be available.

3. On 28 Mach 2016, the Registry informed the parties that an English translation of the application was now available through the eFiling portal.

4. On 21 April 2016, the Respondent filed his reply in which he contends that the application is without merit and requests it to be dismissed.

Consideration

5. From the parties' submissions, it follows that the parties seem to agree on factual background of the case and that the dispute rather concerns whether, under the given circumstances, it was appropriate or not for the Under-Secretary-General for Management to dismiss the Applicant's two complaints. After having closely perused the case record, the Tribunal is of the view that all relevant facts appear to have been properly documented. However, before adjudicating on the matters before it, the Tribunal will allow the Applicant, as the moving party, to respond to the submissions included in the Respondent's reply.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. By **5:00 p.m. on Friday, 12 August 2016**, the Applicant is to file his comments, if any, to the submissions included in the Respondent's reply. The submission is not to exceed five pages, using Times New Roman, size 12, with a line spacing of 1.5. No further submissions will be allowed without the Tribunal's explicit permission.
