ORDER

Introduction

1. On 22 July 2019, by Order No. 111 (NY/2019), the Tribunal rejected the Applicant's application for suspension of action.
2. On the same day, the Applicant filed comments on Order No. 111 (NY/2019), and on 25 July 2019, the Applicant filed the motion for correction of Order No. 111 (NY/2019).

Consideration

3. In the present motion, the Applicant has not requested a correction of clerical or arithmetical mistakes or errors arising from any accidental slip or omission, as provided for in art. 12.2 of the Tribunal's Statute. The Applicant is trying to reargue her case and hence in essence requesting a revision of Order No. 111 (NY/2019).
4. Article 2.2 of the Tribunal's Statute makes it clear that the Tribunal's decision on an application for suspension of action shall not be subject to appeal, and art. 12.1 of its Statute only allows a party to request for revision of an "executable judgment", not of an order on application for suspension of action (see, for example, *Woinowsky-Krieger* Order No. 67 (GVA/2010)). Accordingly, the present motion is inadmissible and is thereby rejected.

Conclusion

5. The motion is rejected.
