Introduction

1. On 22 September 2017, the Applicant, a Resident Investigator at the P-3 level with the Office of Internal Oversight Services (“OIOS”), filed an application contesting the refusal of the Administration to grant an exception to the application of the eligibility of the Applicant to be considered for a continuing appointment.

2. On 27 October 2017, the Respondent filed a reply contending that an exception cannot be granted under staff rule 12.3 as such an exception would be inconsistent with a decision of the General Assembly.

3. The Tribunal notes that in support of his appeal, the Applicant submits an internal memorandum dated 13 February 2017, in which OIOS requests the then Office for Human Resources Management (“OHRM”) to grant an exception for the Applicant’s eligibility for a continuing appointment. In this memorandum, OIOS states that the Applicant “has been repeatedly deemed ineligible for a continuing appointment”.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 8 November 2019**, the Respondent shall confirm when the decision(s) to find the Applicant ineligible for a continuing appointment was notified to the Applicant and provide the supporting documentation.
