# **ON CASE MANAGEMENT**

## Introduction

1. By Order No. 176 (NY/2019), the Tribunal directed the Respondent, by 23 December 2019, to file additional documentation and information. The Tribunal noted that it would thereafter consider the information provided and give further case management directions.

2. By Order No. 182 (NY/2019), the Tribunal granted the parties' joint motion for suspension of the proceedings for 30 days until 22 January 2020 to allow the parties to enter into the *inter partes* negotiations to resolve this case amicably.

3. On 22 January 2020, the parties requested additional suspension of the proceedings for two weeks until 5 February 2020, explaining that "they have made significant progress in their informal settlement negotiation". The parties request a further suspension to conclude the ongoing settlement discussions.

4. In light of the above,

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

5. The joint motion for suspension of the proceedings for two weeks until 5 February 2020 is granted;

6. By **4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, 5 February 2020**, the parties are to inform the Tribunal whether the informal settlement discussions have been successful. If so, the Applicant is also to file a motion to withdraw her application in light of the amicable settlement of her application. If not, the Respondent is to file the documentation and information as per Order No. 176 (NY/2019).
