1. On 14 February 2019, the Applicant filed an application contesting “the implied decision not to make reasonable effort to place [him] on a suitable vacancy following the abolition of his post”.

2. On 18 March 2019, the Respondent filed his reply stating, *inter alia*, that the application is not receivable because the Applicant’s appointment was not terminated and, therefore, staff rule 9.6(e) on retention of staff does not apply.

3. For an efficient and expeditious management of this case, the Tribunal finds it necessary to receive the Applicant’s observations on the issue of receivability.
