- 1. By Order No. 82 (NY/2020) of 4 May 2020, the Tribunal admitted into evidence photographs submitted by the Respondent showing the premises of the Residual Mechanism for the International Criminal Tribunals ("RMICT"). This evidence was presented by the Respondent in rebuttal to evidence previously submitted by the Applicant.
- 2. The Tribunal further informed the parties that it was fully briefed, notwithstanding the testimonial evidence to be heard in court, and that no additional evidence would be admitted unless otherwise ordered by the Tribunal.
- 3. On the same day, the Applicant filed a submission requesting leave to file additional photographic evidence in response to the rebuttal evidence submitted by the Respondent concerning the RMICT premises' layout.
- 4. Considering the short notice with which the Respondent's evidence was presented, the Tribunal exceptionally grants the Applicant's motion to submit photographic evidence. The Tribunal shall not entertain any further motions on evidence.

6. The additional request for submission of evidence by the Applicant is granted. By **4 p.m. on Monday, 4 May 2020**, the Applicant shall upload the photographic evidence onto the Tribunal's electronic filing system for transmittal to the Respondent.
