Introduction

1. On 7 April 2019, the Applicant filed an application wherein he describes the contested decision at the relevant paragraph "V. Details of the Contested Decision" as the "decision not to set the record straight and clear [his] name and refusal to provide a safe working environment".

2. On 13 May 2019, the Respondent filed his reply submitting that the application is not receivable on several grounds, including that the Applicant fails to identify any reviewable administrative decision in his application.

3. Pursuant to Order No. 149 (NY/2020), on 16 October 2020, the Applicant filed a response to the Respondent's contentions on receivability raised in the reply.

Consideration

4. Having reviewed the parties' submissions, the Tribunal considers that it is fully briefed and will proceed to decide the preliminary issue of receivability on the papers before it.
