Introduction

1. On 28 October 2020, as directed in Order No. 161 (NY/2020) of 21 October 2020, the Respondent responded to the Applicants' new submissions on the matter of remedies.

2. In his submission, the Respondent states that on 24 May 2019, the Department of Safety and Security advertised a job opening for six positions of Security Sergeant at the S-4 level (Job Opening No. 116620) similar to the ones concerned in the present proceedings. The Respondent states that four of the six Applicants applied to this job opening and two of them did not.

3. The Tribunal notes that the Respondent does not clarify whether any of the four Applicants who applied to Job Opening No. 116620 were successful in their application. For the completeness of the record, the Tribunal finds it appropriate to seek clarification from the Respondent in this respect.
