Introduction

1. On 11 and 12 May 2021, the Tribunal held hearings to receive testimony from several witnesses after which, the Tribunal informed the parties that they would be provided further instructions on the submission of written closing statements.

2. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

3. By **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 25 May 2021**, the Applicant shall file his closing statement, which shall not exceed seven pages, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing. Aside from the Applicant's submissions pertaining to the oral evidence provided at the hearings, the closing statement shall only cover previously submitted pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence shall be allowed at this stage;

4. By **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 1 June 2021**, the Respondent shall file his closing statement responding to the Applicant's closing statement, which shall not exceed seven pages, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing. Aside from responding to the Applicant's submissions in the closing statement, the Respondent's closing statement will only cover previously filed pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence are allowed at this stage;

5. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 7 June 2021**, the Applicant may file his final observations responding to the Respondent's closing statement. This statement shall not exceed two pages, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing and shall only cover previously filed pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence are allowed at this stage.

6. Unless otherwise ordered, on receipt of the latest of the aforementioned statements or at the expiration of the provided deadlines, the Tribunal will proceed to adjudicate the matter.
