2. In the motion filed on this day, the Applicant submits that in the course of her testimony, the parties may ask questions relating to the Applicant's medical information and refer to some of her medical records included in the Applicant's trial bundle.

3. In order to protect the privacy of Applicant's medical information, she requests that this part of the hearing be held *in camera* without the presence of the public.

4. Having reviewed the Applicant's motion and in order to protect the Applicant's personal data as provided by art. 11.6 of the Dispute Tribunal's Statute and art. 26 of its Rules of Procedure, the Applicant's request to hold a part of its hearing *in camera* is granted.

5. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. The Applicant's motion is granted;

7. During the open court session scheduled for 14 October 2021, the Applicant will take the floor first for 30 minutes and will be cross-examined by the Respondent for 30 minutes. In a closed court session, the parties's Counsel will be allowed to put questions relating to the Applicant's medical information for 10 minutes each, and the Applicant may thereafter address the Tribunal for up to 10 minutes;

8. All logistical aspects related to the holding of the closed session will be coordinated through the New York Registry.
