Introduction

- 1. By Order No. 058 (NY/2022) dated 29 June 2022, the Tribunal ordered: (a) the parties to jointly file consolidated lists of agreed and disputed facts; and (b) each party to file submissions on possible additional evidence.
- 2. The parties duly filed their submissions within the given time limit of 22 July 2022.

Witnesses at a hearing

3. Regarding the possibility of calling witnesses to a hearing, the Applicant requests to be heard in evidence-in-chief. The Applicant further requests to hear in cross-examination "the two members of the Investigative Panel" as well as "the various individuals upon whose evidence the Administration rely for the findings of misconduct" but without stipulating who these individuals are. The Respondent indicates 11 named witnesses, whom he wishes to be called in direct evidence. The Tribunal will therefore order the Applicant to inform which individuals she wishes to hear in cross-examination and then allow the Respondent to comment thereupon.

Disclosure of further documentation

4. Encompassed in the Applicant's submissions, she refers to a range of documentation, which she wishes to be disclosed by the Respondent. The Respondent states that he does not request that any additional information be disclosed.

5. Before deciding upon the Applicant's disclosure requests, the Tribunal will instruct the Respondent to comment thereupon and then allow the Applicant to provide her observation thereto.

6. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

7. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 19 September 2022**, the Applicant is to state all the names of the individuals whom she wishes to cross-examine;

8. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 26 September 2022**, the Respondent is to provide his submissions on (a) the Applicant's disclosure requests and (b) all the named individuals whom the Applicant wishes to cross-examine;

9. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 10 October 2022**, the Applicant is to file her observations on the Respondent's 26 September 2022 submission.
