## **Introduction**

1. On 23 October 2022, the Applicant filed the application in which he contested “the 10 May 2022 decision to disclose his confidential personal and medical information to other staff members who had no right to be provided with this information, which violated the Applicant’s right to privacy”.

2. On 28 October 2022, the Respondent filed a motion for summary judgment by which he contended that the application “is manifestly not receivable as a matter of law and should be decided by way of summary judgment”.

3. By Order No. 101 (NY/2022) dated 8 November 2022, the Tribunal rejected the motion for a summary judgment but determined that the issue of receivability be determined as a preliminary matter. The Applicant was further requested to file his observation in response to the Respondent’s contentions on non-receivability by 21 November 2022.

4. On 11 December 2022, the Applicant filed a “motion on withdrawal” in which he “moves to withdraw the instant case” and that “[i]f granted, this request will bring these proceedings to an end”.

## **Consideration**

5. Taking note of the Applicant’s 11 December 2022 motion on withdrawal, the Tribunal will grant the motion and close the case.

6. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

7. The Applicant’s 11 December 2022 motion on withdrawal is granted;

8. There being no matter remaining for adjudication by the Dispute Tribunal, Case No. UNDT/NY/2022/051 is hereby closed.
