Introduction

1. On 25 April 2022, the Applicant, a former staff member of the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management (“DGCAM”), filed an application with the Tribunal contesting the decision to terminate his permanent appointment for unsatisfactory service. The Applicant requests the Tribunal to rescind the contested decision and to grant him compensation for material and moral damages.
2. On 25 May 2022, the Respondent filed his reply to the application arguing that the contested decision is lawful and requesting the Tribunal to dismiss the application.
3. On 15 March 2023, the present case was assigned to the undersigned Judge and was included in his docket for his current deployment.

Consideration

4. Having considered the parties’ submissions to date and the evidence on record, the Tribunal finds that the matter can be determined on the papers without holding a hearing.
5. Consequently, the parties can proceed to file their closing submissions. In his closing submissions, the Applicant shall include his comments, if any, on the Respondent’s reply.

6. By **Monday, 17 April 2023**, the parties shall file their respective closing submissions.
