## **Introduction**

1. On 14 July 2023, the Applicant, a Youth and Adolescent Development Officer with UNICEF, filed an application requesting the suspension of the implementation of the decision not to renew his fixed-term appointment pending management evaluation (the “contested decision”).

2. On 18 July 2023, the Respondent filed a reply stating that he undertakes not to implement the contested decision, pending completion of the management evaluation process.

## **Considerations**

3. In light of the Respondent’s undertaking not to implement the contested decision, the Applicant has now received the interim remedy he sought. Consequently, the application is moot (see, for instance, the Appeals Tribunal in *Toson* 2021-UNAT-1161, para. 27; *Guetgemann* 2022-UNAT-1201, para. 22; *Mboob* 2022-UNAT-1215, para. 33).

4. The application is dismissed.
