Introduction

1. By Order No. 079 (NY/2023) dated 11 September 2023, the Tribunal, as relevant to the present Order, instructed the parties to (a) confer with a view to resolving the matters in the present case informally, and (b) by 25 September 2023, file a jointly-signed statement informing the Tribunal whether they agreed to attempt informal resolution, and if so, request a suspension of the proceedings.
