## **Introduction**

1. On 6 March 2023, the Applicant, a former staff member with the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (“MINUSMA”), filed an application regarding the post-separation entitlements paid to him.
2. The Respondent filed a motion on 16 March 2023 submitting that the application was not receivable and requested that the Dispute Tribunal determine the receivability of the application as a preliminary matter.
3. By Order No. 085 (NY/2023) dated 13 September 2023, the Tribunal ordered, *inter alia*, the Applicant to file a response to the Respondent’s motion dated 16 March 2023.
4. The Applicant duly filed his submission on 16 October 2023.

## **Considerations**

5. Having reviewed the parties’ submissions, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the interest of justice to determine the receivability of the application as a preliminary matter.
6. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Dispute Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure,

### **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

7. The Respondent’s motion to determine the receivability of the application as a preliminary matter is granted;
8. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 3 November 2023**, the Respondent is to file his closing submissions on receivability. This statement is not to be longer than five pages using Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing;

9. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 17 November 2023**, the Applicant is to file his arguments, if any, to the Respondent's closing submissions. This statement is not to be longer than five pages using Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing.
