## ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

#### Introduction

1. Via Order No. 094 (NY/2023) dated 2 October 2023 and Order No. 098 (NY/2023) dated 4 October 2023, the Tribunal instructed the Applicant to resubmit his application in compliance with the requirements of art. 6 of the Tribunal's Practice Direction No. 4 on Filing Applications and Replies.

2. On 12 October 2023, the Applicant complied with the instruction.

3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion ("CMD"). The purpose of the CMD shall be to identify, discuss and agree on the claims and issues in the case and generally to deal with any other matter which may facilitate a fair and expeditious disposal of the case and to do justice to the parties.

#### Considerations

4. Article 19 of the Rules of Procedure of the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or Tribunal) provides that the Dispute Tribunal may at any time, either on an application of a party or on its own initiative, issue any order or give any direction which appears to a judge to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of the case and to do justice to the parties. In furtherance of this provision and in consultation with the parties,

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

A CMD shall take place on Wednesday, 1 November 2023 at 10:00 a.m.
New York City time via Microsoft Teams.
