Introduction

1. On 15 September 2023, the Applicant, Senior Security Officer, United Nations Department of Safety and Security (“UNDSS”), (S-3, Step 11), filed an application contesting the decision of the Captain, Central Scheduling Unit, UNDSS (“C/CSU”) to place him on the “Priority Two” list with respect to his request to work overtime on 10 April 2023 (the “contested decision”).

2. On 16 October 2023, the Respondent filed his reply contending that the application is not receivable *ratione materiae* because the contested decision is not a reviewable administrative decision within the meaning of art. 2.1(a) of the Statute of the Dispute Tribunal. The Respondent further submitted that should the Dispute Tribunal find that the Application is receivable, it lacks merit.

Consideration

3. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Rules of Procedure of the Dispute Tribunal, the Tribunal may at any time issue an order or give any direction which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of a case and to do justice to the parties.

4. Having taken into consideration the pleadings of the parties, the Tribunal has concluded that the Applicant should file further submissions.
