Introduction

1. On 9 November 2023, the Applicant, a staff member of the United Nations Secretariat based in New York, filed an application contesting "the Administration's decision denying her request for income tax reimbursement for tax year 2019".

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 11 December 2023 submitting that the application "has no merit" and that the contested decision was lawful.

3. On 13 December 2024, the Applicant filed a notice of withdrawal, indicating that "[a]s the contested administrative decision in the instant matter [...] has been resolved and the Administration has met its obligation to the Applicant in this regard, the dispute in this case has thereby been rendered moot without the need for a settlement agreement between the parties, or the filing of a rejoinder".

4. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

5. As the Applicant has withdrawn the application, there being no matter remaining for adjudication by the Dispute Tribunal, Case No. UNDT/NY/2023/041 is hereby closed.
