#### Introduction

1. The Applicant, a staff member with the Department of Global Communications in New York, filed a motion on 24 November 2025 requesting an extension of time to file an application.

- 2. The Respondent filed his response on 4 December 2025 opposing the motion.
- 3. Also on 4 December 2025 (after the close of business), the Applicant filed his application.

#### **Considerations**

- 4. As the Applicant has filed an application on 4 December 2025, the motion for extension of time has become moot.
- 5. The Tribunal notes that in the application, the Applicant, who is self-represented, submits that "[i]f the Tribunal warrants an extension of time pursuant to Applicant's motion in this regard (which was opposed by Respondent), Applicant would like the opportunity to present a revised Application once he can obtain [Office of Staff Legal Assistance, "OSLA"] support".
- 6. Having examined the Applicant's motion and application, the Tribunal does not consider it necessary to delay the proceedings in this case or to order the filing of a revised application at this time. However, should the Applicant later obtain legal representation, his Counsel can then make the appropriate motion, if deemed relevant.

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 8. The Applicant's motion for extension of time to file his application is moot.
- 9. The Applicant's request to file a revised application is denied.
