Event: Expert meeting on Bosnia and Herzegovina's Voluntary National

## 1. **Objectives of the meeting**

To exchange information on the current status of implementation of resolution 1540 (2004), and to assist Bosnia and Herzegovina with the drafting of their voluntary National Implementation Action Plan (NAP) related to resolution 1540 (2004).

# 2. **Background**

In accordance with Operative Paragraph 8 of Security Council Resolution 1977 (2011), all States were encouraged to prepare, on a voluntary basis, national implementation action plans, with the assistance of the 1540 Committee as appropriate, which maps out their priorities and plans for implementing the key provisions of resolution 1540 (2004). States were also encouraged to submit those plans to the 1540 Committee. The development of a voluntary National Implementation Action Plan is a tool to assist States to plan their future activities in implementing the resolution. On the website of the 1540 Committee, (http://www.un.org/en/sc/1540/national-implementation/national-action-plans.shtml), such plans for Argentina, Canada, France, Serbia and the United States of America have been published. A number of other States are in the process of drafting such plans.

On 6 March 2013, the 1540 Committee received an invitation from the OSCE to participate, in collaboration with the UNODA, in an expert meeting with the representatives of Bosnia and Herzegovina to assist with the development of their voluntary National Implementation Action Plan. From 3-4 April 2013, such a meeting took place in Vienna, Austria, in which representatives from the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the OSCE, UNODA and two of the 1540 Committee experts participated.

## 3. **Highlights of discussions**

At the meeting information was exchanged on the current status of implementation of resolution 1540 (2004), as well as progress made by Bosnia and Herzegovina on the implementation of the resolution. Views were exchanged on the elements of a draft NAP for Bosnia and Herzegovina, and an outline of such a NAP was completed for further consideration and elaboration by the various national stakeholders of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
