

Call for Papers for a Special Issue on Sustainable tourism
Deadline for submission: 31 August 2012

Natural Resources Forum, a United Nations Sustainable Development Journal, a quarterly journal issued by the Division for Sustainable Development of the United Nations, calls for papers for a **special issue on sustainable tourism, to be published in 2013**.

Articles submitted for this special section should be relevant to policymaking, and should address tourism from a sustainable development perspective, i.e. treating economic, social, and environmental aspects in an integrated way. Angles of interest can include:

- Implications of global or regional trends in tourism for sustainable development and poverty eradication in developing countries, including small islands (including “environmentally-friendly” forms of tourism)
- Analysis of the sector’s structure and implications for the sharing of benefits from tourism across developed and developing countries, as well as within receiving countries
- Integrated assessments of tourism development at the regional or national level
- Economic, environmental and social impacts of the tourism sector at the national level
 - Assessment of national policies, regulations and incentives for sustainable tourism: how successful have they been?
 - Links between tourism and other economic sectors: how are conflicts, synergies managed, and what is the impact on long-term development perspectives in receiving countries?
 - Sub-sector focuses (e.g. eco-tourism, nature-related tourism), implementation challenges for developing countries (institutional capacity, stakeholders’ involvement, sustainability of the industry)
- Trends and innovation in tourism: what implications for sustainability
- Case studies on sustainable tourism at the local or national level

Articles should contain original material and should be between 6,000 and 8,000 words in length.
