**STATEMENT**  
**of H.E. Mirgul Moldoisaeva,**  
**Permanent Representative of the Kyrgyz Republic to the United Nations**  
**at the 2017 ECOSOC Forum on Financing for Development follow-up**  
**(23 May 2017)**

**Thank you Mr. President,**

ECOSOC Forum on Financing for development follow up creates a crucial platform to evaluate the progress we have made. A first assessment prepared by the interagency task is also an important contribution to the monitor process. We believe that today's discussions and sharing of views on our opportunities and challenges is the most coherent way toward to partnership in SDG implementation and financing.

**Mr. President,**

The way for sustainable development was determined by Kyrgyzstan in 2013. Referencing the National Strategy, we work strenuously to ensure economic growth, social welfare and environmental preservation. Our National Sustainable Development Strategy will be over this year. The Strategy has laid a good foundation for our transaction to SDG realization, based on national priority and in line with the global agenda.

To date Kyrgyzstan has been taking important steps for the Agenda 2030 supported by the Addis-Ababa plan of action implemented. We have created the institutional base for implementation and monitoring the sustainable development process. The assessment delivered both by the Government and the President.

To ensure holistic approaches, we synchronized the timing for adoption of the new National country program and the UNDAF. Adopted few days ago UNDAF for the next five years focused on four main priorities:

- Sustainable and inclusive economic growth including industry and agricultural development, food security and nutrition;
- Good governance, rule of law, human rights and gender equality;
- Environment, climate change and disaster risk management;
- Social protection, health care and education.

The new National country program will be adopted shortly and as well as sustainable development goals in its three dimensions aims in addressing the global challenges of poverty eradication, food security and climate change. Priority directions of the Government's work are given to sustainable economic development, strengthening

of democracy, improving the quality of health care, education, preservation of priceless natural resources and ecology. The Introduction of an e-government system aims to support and increase efficiency of SDG implementation. The key project of the new country program is named "Taza-Koom" and will play a pivotal role in a smart investment in people and technologies.

"Taza Koom" - is a state project of the Kyrgyz Republic created by using modern technologies and digital data. It is aimed for restructuring of managerial and operational processes in the state, including public services. Also the project will provide assistance in the business transformation, as well as in the technology development of "smart" cities and regions. "Taza Koom" is a tool of creating a new favorable environment in the Kyrgyz Republic, which will penetrate all spheres of life, as well as in the state/citizen relations. This project is designed to significantly improve the people's quality of life, to ensure their rights, freedoms and the access to quality healthcare and education.

Kyrgyzstan uses all reasonable efforts and seeks how to meet the financial and technology transfer gaps in order to achieve these ambitious goals toward to the sustainable development path.

In conclusion Mr. President we would like to reiterate our readiness to continue working on our collective commitments.
