






IMPLICATIONS

- 
~ 2 x global bioenergy supply
 → Huge increase in modern biomass due to transition from traditional biomass
- 
Universal access to modern cooking solutions
 → Eliminating 4 million premature deaths annually
- 
~ 3 x bioenergy related jobs globally
 → from 2.9 million (2015) to 9.1 million jobs (2030)
- 
Beyond 2°C → 1.5°C pathway
- 
~ 2 – 3 times more investment in renewable energy
~ 4 – 15 times cost-to-benefit ration
