

International Conference 2018

- Focus on SDG Target 15.2 "halting deforestation" and UNSPF Target 1.1 "increasing forest area by 3%"
- Input to HLPF 2018 through UNFF13
- Organized by CPF
- Participants: multi-sector, involvement of private sector
- Budget: USD 400,000, voluntary contributions needed



Key activities for 2017

- Develop new CPF Policy Document, including Rules of Procedure
- Review of existing Joint Initiatives and consideration of proposed new ones
- Develop concept and modalities of CPF Dialogue to actively involve major groups and other stakeholders
- Develop CPF work plan
- Contribute to Expert Group Meeting to develop format for voluntary national reporting
- Prepare conference planned for 2018
