<u>Building on our past comments, GER renders important the enhancement of exchange of experiences and interaction at the Forum's technical sessions. Recognizing past achievements in this regard, we see several options to further enhance the interactivity of the Forum.</u>

- There should be time allocated for VNC reflections, both announcements and lessons-learnt.
 This could be addressed by a specific time slot or agenda item.
- Panels should further be introduced with guiding questions leading to discussions about and outcomes on coherence of actions, potential CPF-activities, up-scaling of activities and potential South-South cooperation.
- In our view, it is not the question to reduce the number of panels but the number of panelists to allow more time for exchange of experiences among participants.
- Furthermore, the practice to invite panelists from outside the usual forest policy "world" should be intensified.
- Possibilities to work with modern moderation and communication tools in order to strengthen exchange among participants should be further explored.

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
