

## Questionnaire on the Forum's 4POW 2021-2024

1. Thematic priorities: The 4POW 2021-2024 consists of two technical-policy biennium: 2021-2022 and 2023-2024. Consistent with Annex II of ECOSOC resolution 2017/4, the Forum's odd- and even-year sessions for each biennium will be thematically linked on the basis of the GFGs and targets, taking into account the post-2020 programme of work of the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF). In order to carry out this guidance, would it be useful for the work programme to (check one):

- a.  Identify three GFGs and associated targets as thematic priorities for a technical exchange of experiences among Member States and partners and a subsequent policy review in each biennium (progress on all GFGs are reviewed in the four-year period), taking into account the post 2020 HLPF programme of work?

Nigeria's choices of the three GFGs is anchored on a prioritization that seeks to ensure that the selected GFGs address to the extent possible the envisaged outcomes of any GFG not amongst these three. Thus GFGs 1, 2 and 5 should engage the attention the the Forum and generic reasons are included below:

**i. GFG 1 - Reverse the loss of forest cover worldwide through sustainable forest management, including protection, restoration, afforestation and reforestation, and increase efforts to prevent forest degradation and contribute to the global effort of addressing climate change.**

GFG 1 comes top of our suggested priorities as it is sufficiently in line with Nigeria's forestry development and climate extremes amelioration programmes. Most importantly, it provides the foundation for the success of nature-based solutions in reducing the impact of climate change. In addition, the Goal and its associated targets 1.1 – 1.4 have considerably addressed GFG 3 and its associated targets.

**ii. GFG 2 - Enhance forest-based economic, social and environmental benefits, including by improving the livelihoods of forest dependent people.**

GFG 2 and its associated targets 2.1 – 2.5 should be the second thematic priority more so that this GFG can easily resonate with the intent of GFG 4 in mobilising financial resources to the extent that enhanced economic benefits guarantees both the public and private sector generate enough revenue to be able to plough back into efforts at sustaining such revenue base. A direct corollary to this is that improving livelihoods of the forest dependent people also provides avenues for initiatives that would obviate deforestation and forest degradation challenges associated with unsustainable use by forest dependent communities. This would translate to the efficient and effective use of available limiting financial resources for activities that improve sustainable forest management,

**GFG 5 - Promote governance frameworks to implement sustainable forest management, including through the UN Forest Instrument, and enhance the contribution of forests to the 2030 Agenda and strengthen scientific and technical cooperation and partnerships.**

In suggesting GFG 5 as the third most important priority, Nigeria is conscious of the fact that the adoption of appropriate, efficient and effective governance frameworks – across all levels (Sub-National, Regional and Internationally) and sectors (Public, Private, CSOs, NGOs etc) provides the foundation for ensuring linkages and complementarities to enhance Sustainable Forest Management. This can also be seen as having the potential of addressing GFG 6.

- b.  Leave the decision on which GFGs will be the themes for each biennium to the Bureau (current practice) in order to take into account, the post-2020 HLPF programme of work, which is expected to be agreed upon before the end of 2019? OR

Endangered Species of Fauna and Flora. More so that a number of countries yield substantial revenue from the exploitation of these resources – which at times are done unsustainably.
