## EU INPUT FOR THE KEY MESSAGES OF THE HIGH-LEVEL DECLARATION OF UNFF15

The European Union and its Member States highlight the following aspects when preparing the draft high-level declaration for UNFF15.

- The declaration should be succinct and forward-looking, prioritising those topics that are deemed most important
- The declaration should be built around three central elements:
  - 1. The work of UNFF and its secretariat and Collaborative Partnership on Forests
  - 2. The forest-related global policy agenda
  - 3. High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development 2020
- 1. On **UNFF and its secretariat, and the CPF**, the EU and its Member States wish to concentrate on the following:
  - Appreciate the renewal of UNFF in 2015, the UNSPF and the outcomes of the quadrennial programme of work of the Forum for 2017–2020
  - Focus on the priorities for the next quadrennial programme of work of the Forum for 2021–2024
  - Focus on the priorities for the CPF work plan for 2021–2024
  - Focus on the interlinkages and synergies between the two programmes
- 2. On the **forest-related global policy agenda**, the EU and its Member States wish to concentrate on the following:
  - Relationship with Agenda 2030, including the Sustainable Development Goals
  - The 15th meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity and the post-2020 biodiversity framework
  - Climate change mitigation and adaptation
  - Land-use and land-use change
- 3. On **High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development 2020**, the EU and its Member States wish to concentrate on the following:
  - The forest sector's contribution to the HLPF 2020 themes
    - o The EU is prepared to provide additional input at a later stage
