The Preparatory Committee decides to recommend that the United Nations Conference to Review Progress Made in the Implementation of the Programme of Action to Prevent, Combat and Eradicate the Illicit Trade in Small Arms and Light Weapons in All Its Aspects elect 29 Vice Presidents, comprising five representatives from the Asian Group and six from each of the other regional groups. Nominations should take place at an early stage to permit the president-designate to benefit from the support of the bureau during his preparations for the Conference.

The rules of procedure as contained in document A/CONF.192/L.1 shall be amended accordingly.
